



**Security Agreement
For Physicians and Physician's Office Personnel**

By downloading and installing the Philips iSite Enterprise Client software or accessing the Provider Portal, you are agreeing to the terms and conditions set forth in this agreement.

1. Authenticated Users – The Provider Portal allows users to view patient radiologic reports and submit scheduling requests. The Philips iSite Enterprise Client allows the user to view patient radiologic studies and reports from Advanced Medical Imaging. As such, the user is bound by all appropriate HIPAA compliance standards. Any violation of these standards is grounds for immediate termination of user privileges. Additionally, the authorized user agrees to not disclose any assigned usernames and passwords to unauthorized or authorized personnel and to employ reasonable security means to protect such usernames and passwords. Office personnel should not share the username or password with anyone. You must login under your own assigned account. The user also agrees to notify Advanced Medical Imaging IT staff of any potential violations of security and any unauthorized use of the Philips iSite Enterprise client software.

2. Secure Connection to Advanced Medical Imaging - Access to the Advanced Medical Imaging iSite Enterprise PACS and the Provider Portal is done through a server at Advanced Medical Imaging. Any detected attempts to access the system without authorization may result in criminal prosecution.

3. Warranty - Advanced Medical Imaging makes no warranty which places Advanced Medical Imaging as responsible for the quality of images or the quality of the Internet connection that the user employs. Furthermore, Advanced Medical Imaging makes no warranty as to any effects that the use of the Philips iSite Enterprise software has on the user's workstation(s). The software is provided for downloading, as is. In no event shall Advanced Medical Imaging be liable for any lost revenue, profit or data, or, for special, indirect, consequential, incidental or punitive damages however caused and regardless of the theory of liability arising out of the use of and or inability to use the software even if Advanced Medical Imaging or its suppliers are notified of the possibility of such damages.

If, for any reason, you become aware that someone has discovered your access code, please notify Information Systems at 303/433-9729 immediately and the appropriate action will be taken. If an employee who is a user of the system resigns or is terminated, please notify our office immediately so we can deny their access to the system.
